About His Eminence Menri Ponlob Trinley Nyima Rinpoche:

A lineage holder of the Tibetan Bon tradition. After 13 years of studying Sutra, Tantra, Dzogchen, ritual, grammar, poetry, astrology, divination, medicine and paintings of Thangka, making of Mandala, and stupa, he obtained his Geshe degree (equivalent to a doctorate) from the Bon Dialectic School in 1989. Soon afterwards, he was appointed Lupon (Headmaster) of the Bon Dialectic School. In 1992, he was given the name Ponlob, the second most revered position at the Menri Monastery which is the main monastery in all of Tibet as well as the Tibetan exile community in India.
